### MBDS FOUNDING ASSEMBLY

The Malta Bleeding Disorders Society (MBDS) is a non-profit, autonomous, voluntary organization with the following objectives:

1. To provide a fellowship for people with bleeding disorders and those concerned with their health and welfare, and to give advice on their problems.
2. To safeguard the social and economic interests of people with bleeding disorders.
3. To promote the study of the causes and treatment of bleeding disorders.
4. To bring to the notice of the authorities the special needs of people with bleeding disorders and to co-operate with the medical and allied professions to further their care.

The MBDS was founded on Saturday 2nd March 2019 with the first elected committee: President – Dr James Gauci, Secretary – Dr Jonathan Gauci, Treasurer – Rev Can David Cilia, Medical Advisor – Prof Alex Gatt, Members' Representative – Mrs Jacqueline Cilia. The MBDS constitution was drafted at the founding assembly.

The MBDS has successfully enrolled as a Voluntary Organisation with the Office of the Commissioner for Voluntary Organisations as VO/1712. Membership is free and is open to people with bleeding disorders, their families and friends. Donations are needed; any amount is welcome.


